New exhibition of works on paper

'Chinoiserie' new works on paper by Chris Chun will open at the Washhouse Gallery on Tuesday, 21 April. The exhibition will run until Sunday, 10 May. Opening night will be on Thursday, 23 April from 6 – 8pm.

Chinoiserie is the latest exhibition from artist Chris Chun. Inspired by his recent travels to Asia and a love of antique textiles, Chris's paintings reflect an inherent joy and harmony. The beauty of nature and everything within, changes with the seasons. Flowers grow in abundance. Birds & butterflies of every kaleidoscope prosper in their own unique habitat and koi swim happily in the pond of life.

Chris fuses Chinese traditions of flower & bird paintings with contemporary western paper collages. Layers of coloured washes, origami & Japanese papers and a combination of stamped, hand made patterns create ethereal, atmospheric effects.

This is Chris's 4th solo show at the Washhouse Gallery. He has previously shown with Libby Edwards Gallery in Brisbane and Hill Smith Fine Art in Adelaide. Chris has also been a finalist in the Fleurieu Peninsula Biennale Art of Food Prize and Cadry Memorial Art Awards.
